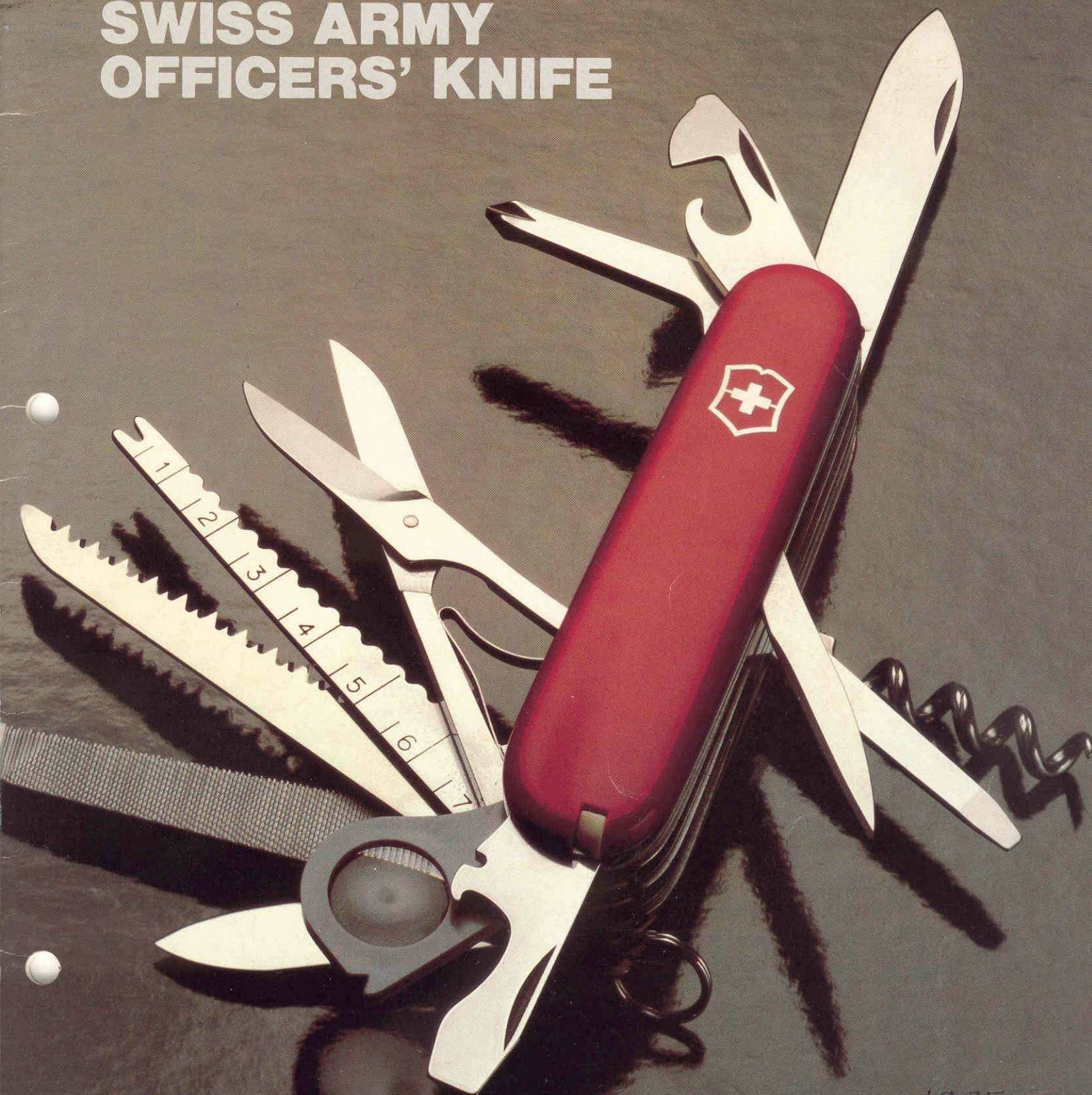

VICTORINOX SWISS ARMY KNIVES—NINETY YEARS OF PRECISION CRAFTSMANSHIP

In 1884, Carl Elsener returned to his native Switzerland after serving a cutlery making apprenticeship in Germany, and began making knives in a one-room factory in Ibach. In 1891 he persuaded the Swiss Army to use a pocket knife of his design instead of a rival German knife.

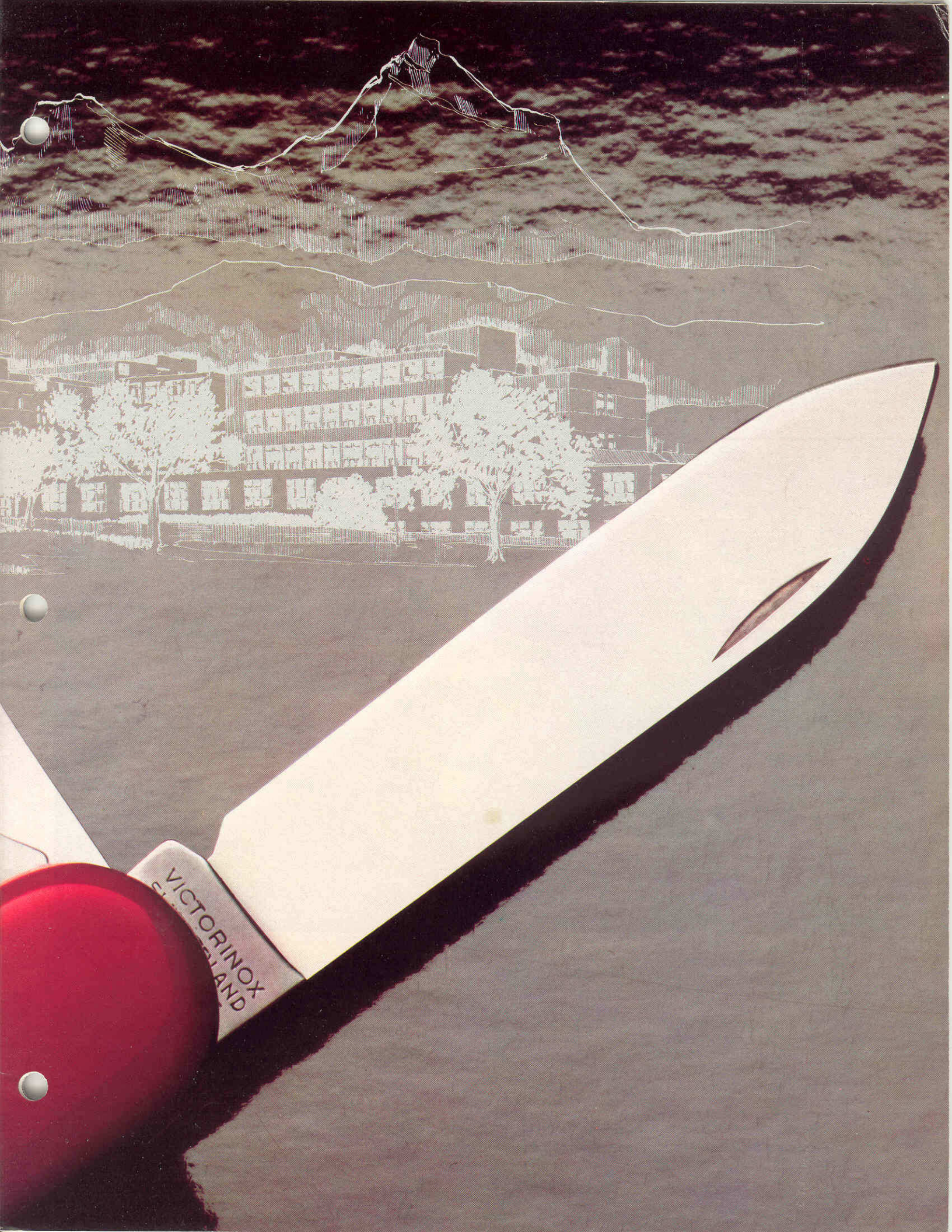
Mr. Elsener named his new company after his wife, Victoria. Shortly after beginning to supply the Swiss Army with his Victoria knives, Elsener developed a concept that revolutionized pocket knives... a knife with six blades that worked with only two springs. This revolutionary knife was patented as the "officer's knife" in 1897. Following the invention of the new knife, Elsener changed the company name by adding the Latin word for steel (nox) to the end of his wife's name — thus Victorinox.

Over the years, the red Victorinox knives became popular throughout the world. After World War II, the Swiss Army Knife became well known in America as returning servicemen brought Swiss Army Knives back as gifts for friends and family. Soon it became the most favored multi-bladed pocket knife in America. Today, the Victorinox Swiss Army Knife a "toolbox" in your pocket, is standard equipment for space shuttle astronauts, K2 and Mount Everest climbers, and explorer Jacques Cousteau. Several U.S. Presidents have had the presidential seal and their signatures embossed on Victorinox knives for prestigious gifts.

The Victorinox standard of excellence continues in the same tradition with the Elsener Swiss family. Victorinox Swiss Army knives have received awards for excellence in design throughout the world, and the Champion model was selected by New York's Museum of Modern Art to be part of a permanent design collection.

Original Victorinox Swiss Army Knives bear the engraved Victorinox shield with the Swiss cross. Look for the Victorinox trademark on the shank of the large blade. This is your assurance that you have the original Victorinox Swiss Army Knife — the first and finest since 1897.

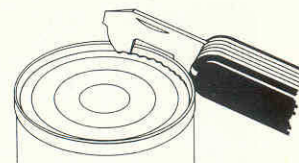
