The **SMALL POCKET-KNIVES** (page 1 to 6) can be delivered with different kinds of handles. When ordering please indicate number and description of handle wanted:

**Celluloid handles** red (Cr), black (Cs), blue (Cb), mother-of-pearl imitation (CP), ivory imitation (CJ), tortoise-shell imitation (CT), and horn imitation (CH). **Aluminium handles** oxidized and tinted: red (Ar), blue (Ab), black (As), golden (Ag), and natural (An). **Genuine first-class horn handles**, finely marbled (H). **Genuine mother-of-pearl handles** (P). **Stainless engine-turned steel handles** (G).

We have about 20 different engine-turned designs. Generally the knives are supplied with assorted drawings. If a special engine-turned design is wanted, kindly add to the letter «G» the number of the desired drawing, f. i. nò. 70 G 12. Our representatives will be glad to show you our different engine-turned designs.

The **OFFICER'S KNIVES** (page 7 to 11) are delivered in two different sizes, i. e. 90 and 83 mm ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ " and  $3\frac{1}{4}$ "). The numbers are alike for the same sizes, but with the smaller type the letter «k» should be added, as an abbreviation for «small size wanted». Besides the normal red Elsenid handles (r) with the Swiss cross, all our types can be delivered with genuine horn handles (H), genuine mother-of-pearl handles (P), beautiful celluloid-mother-of-pearl handles (CP), or with genuine hartshorn handles (HH).

The **POCKET-KNIVES FOR PEASANTS** (page 12 to 16) of ordinary first-class knife steel are manufactured with red (Fr) or black (Fs) fibre handles, or with genuine second-class horn handles (H). The stainless steel knives are made with genuine first-class horn handles only (H).


There are four different sizes for these knives. The first number gives the type, whereas the second number shows the combination of the integrant parts.

**KNIVES FOR SOLDIERS, CADETS AND ELECTRICIANS** (page 17 to 21) are only supplied with red fibre handles.

**GARDENER'S KNIVES** (page 22) are mounted with black celluloid handles (Cs) or with horn handles (H).

**GRAFTING-KNIVES** (page 23) are delivered only with black celluloid handles, **PRUNING KNIVES** with rosewood handles.
